## **To all Sasria Agents and Intermediaries Registered Mobile Plants**

Following circular no 448 regarding Sasria rate increase, there has been confusion about mobile plants. Below please find clarity on how to insure mobile plants registered for road use:

- 1) Mobile plant which is registered for road use but will never be used on the public road should always be insured under CW coupon as normal plant and the plant rate must be used.
- 2) Mobile plant which is registered for road use and are utilized on public road can now be insured under Contract Works coupon (CW) or Motor coupon (ME) depending on the underlying policy and using the mobile plant rate of (0.05% annual rate / 0.005% monthly rate).
- 3) In future we will amend the CW coupon to add the mobile plant section. In the meantime you can show mobile plant by attaching an endorsement and showing that the mobile plant rate has been applied.
- 4) To reduce administration burden for Agent companies, if the total number of mobile plants registered for road use in the client's plants schedule are less 5%, then there is no need to split mobile plant from normal plant when insuring for Sasria purposes, it can be insured as plant using the plant rate.
